

The fund underperformed the MSCI Asia ex-Japan index this month. The main positive contributors to fund performance came from our underweight positions in the Financials, Consumer Staples, and Real Estate sectors. Oil & Gas drilling services company China Oilfield Services, Korean EV materials processor Daebo Magnetic, and Korean battery maker Samsung SDI were our top contributors. We also benefitted from not owning the large internet benchmark names such as Tencent and Alibaba. The main detractors were the Consumer Discretionary, Materials, and Healthcare sectors. Internet search and Al technology company Baidu, new energy auto manufacturer Li Auto, and Chinese short video platform company Kuaishou Technology were the main detractors. Over the month, we increased our weighting in companies exposed to the electric vehicle value chain.
